

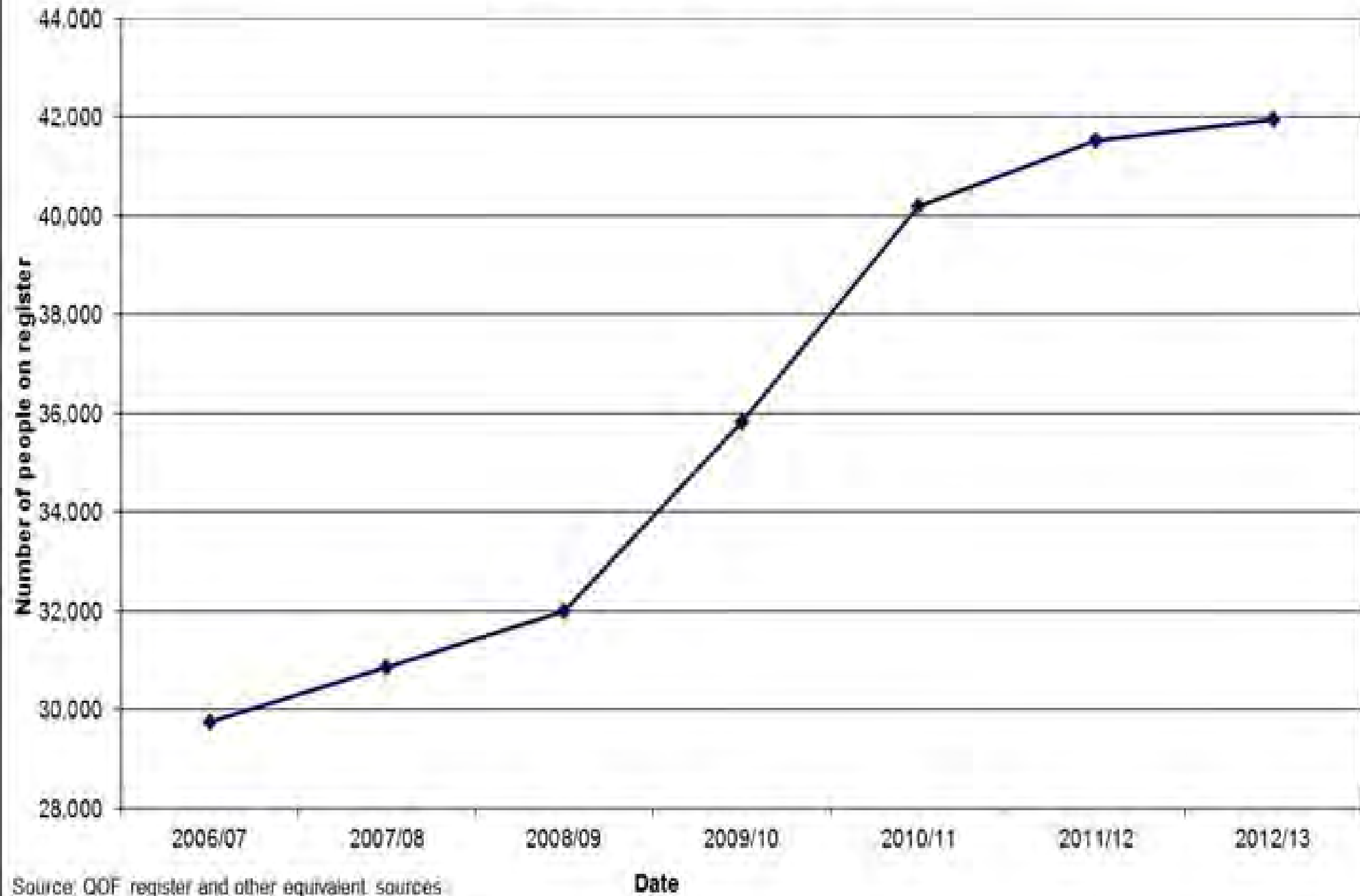

Humanity Principle

Care and support is offered to people with dementia and their families and carers in a way which promotes their wellbeing and quality of life, protects their rights and respects their humanity
